responsibilities

CEO owns policy

The CEO owns the sustainability policy and related policies.

management develops the strategy

The CEO and the Business Development unit are responsible for the sustainability strategy development.

operations implement the strategy

All heads of regions, cities, and departments are responsible for

- implementing and communicating the sustainability policy
- ensuring compliance with the sustainability policy
- reaching the regions', cities', and departments' sustainability targets

Business Development unit sends each head a quarterly scorecard.

Target responsables agree on corrective actions with their manager.

all staff are responsible for sustainability

Each staff member is responsible for

- reading and understanding the policy
- working towards achieving the sustainability targets
- reporting any behavior inconsistent with this policy

the Board approves and reviews the policy

The Board of Directors reviews and approves the sustainability policy and the targets annually.

Business Development unit monitors and evaluates target progress with stakeholders and recommends updates. The CEO proposes policy updates to the Board.

The Sustainability and Construction Committee meets quarterly.

The committee reviews energy and sustainability matters.
